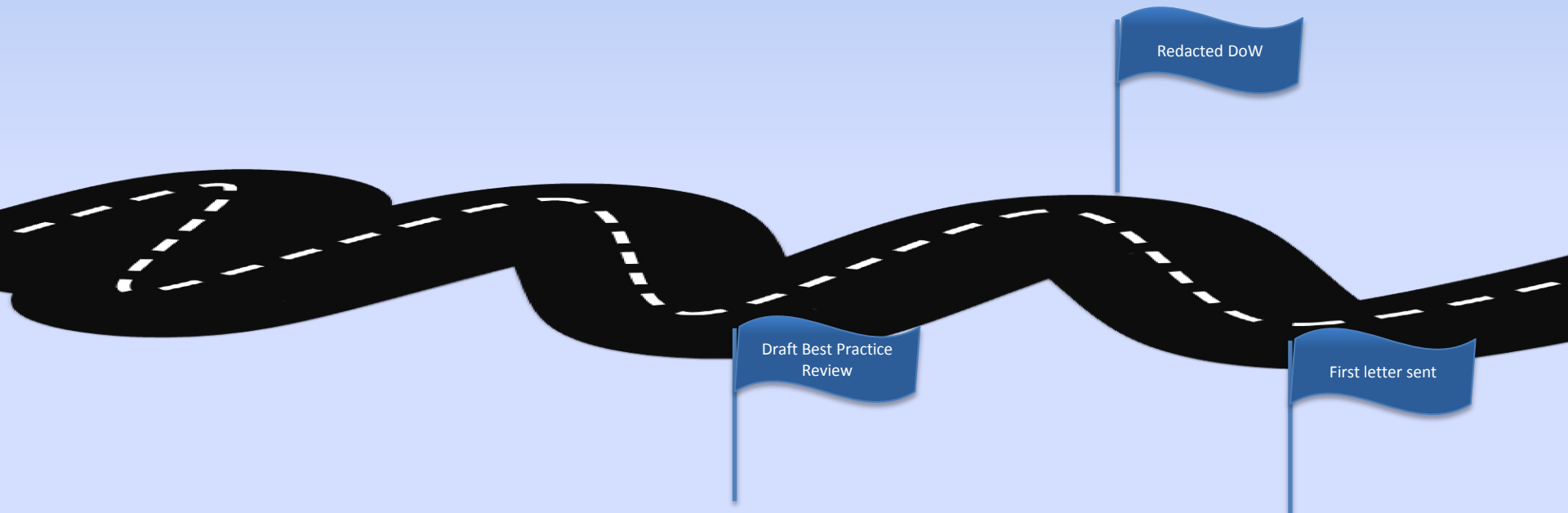

Input: Redacted Description of Work



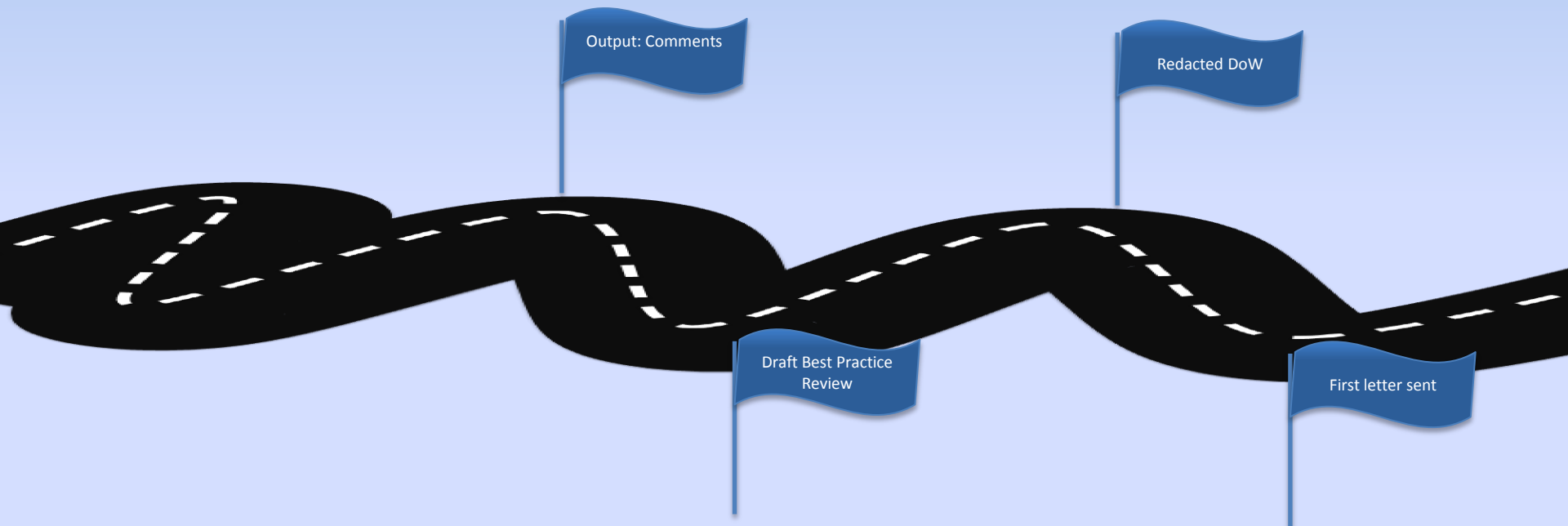
